



MEDICARE ACTIVITIES OVERVIEW

Medicare Word Puzzles

This game is an activity to accompany outreach and education and is appropriate for Medicare training partners or people somewhat familiar with the Medicare program. There are 17 word puzzles presented in PowerPoint® format. Answers appear at the end.

Suggested uses:

- Print out the word puzzles. After a designated amount of time to complete, go through the answers as a group.
- Show the puzzles as a PowerPoint® presentation, with participants writing down answers or calling them out.

Jeopardy Interactive Review

This game is presented in a Jeopardy-like format. It can be an excellent tool to use in the classroom to review and/or learn new content. Used as a learning activity, it serves as a review of key Medicare topics or terminology.

It is appropriate for Medicare training partners and people somewhat familiar with the Medicare program. You can choose to play in teams or individually. Remind participants that their responses should be in the form of a question.

Medicare BINGO

This is a bingo game with a twist. It is a fun and exciting way to teach about Medicare.

The Medicare BINGO game comes with 50 unique BINGO cards and Medicare terms and definitions cards. This game can be played as a game for seniors to familiarize them with Medicare terms or as a training tool for people who work with seniors to learn about Medicare.

Understanding Medicare Board Game

This board game is a fun way to encourage teamwork and test your Medicare knowledge. Players take turns rolling a die and answering Medicare program-related questions. The first player to reach FINISH wins the game.

The Understanding Medicare board game comes with Medicare program questions, special knowledge questions, and an answer sheet. This game can be played in a small group, or you can print multiple games to use in larger meetings.
